

BUU Summer Cultural Camp 2025

Camp period: 22 – 30 June 2025 Venue: Burapha University, Chonburi Campus, Thailand

Introduction

7-day camp focusing on Thai culture, traditions, language, teaching methodology, food, Sport & entertainment. Open for Burapha University students and foreign undergraduates who enrolled in any discipline in non-Thai AUN member Universities and countries in ASEAN+3. Cross-cultural experience with local Thai participants and international participants from other countries. Applicable knowledge of some short courses and international education exposure.

Program Particular

- □ All participants will be provided with three meals a day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) at no cost.
- □ Free accommodation will be provided to all participants.
- □ The university will provide transportation from the international airport (Suvarnabhumi Airport and Don Muang Airport) in Bangkok to Burapha University and back, and all other transportation included in the summer camp will be free of charge.
- □ Laundry and personal expenditures have to be borne by the participants themselves.
- □ All participants are required to cover Air Tickets, International Health Insurance, Personal Expenses, etc.
