# Eligibility to Apply

- Registered as an active student at home university;
- Have completed at least one academic year of study at home university;
- Nominated officially by home university (an official coordinator's full name and email address is required);
- Have good academic standing with CGPA not less than 3.0 or equivalent; and
- Have good command of English in speaking and writing.

# English Language Requirements

- Students who are interested in taking modules at the Faculty of Business & Accountancy (FBA) and Faculty of Law (FOL) are required to fulfil either one of the English requirements below:

Type	IELTS (Academic)	TOEFL IBT	TOEFL PBT	TOEFL CBT	TOEFL ITP	TOEIC
Min. Score	<b>Band 6</b>	<b>80</b>	<b>550</b>	<b>213</b>	<b>627</b>	<b>693</b>

- A Support/Recommendation Letter issued by the Home University's Coordinator to confirm the student's english proficiency will be sufficient for those who wish to study modules from other faculties except FBA & FOL.

# Important Application Documents

- Recent Passport Size Photograph
- Latest Academic Result/Transcript (must be in English)
- A copy of the student's passport (front page with ID)
- English language Examination Result
- Confirmation/Recommendation Letter issued by home university
  - Confirm your student's enrolment status at home university
  - Recommendation to participate for mobility programme at UM
- Scholarship/Sponsorship Letter (if applicable)

# Module Selection & Approval

1. Students are required to select modules they wish to take at UM as part of their online application. It is important for students to refer to the module offered listing and the module information before making a selection on the application form.
2. For your information, there will be a module approval stage whereby the respective faculties will review and approve the students' module selection based on the eligibility and availability of class capacity.
3. Hence, students are advised to select multiple modules from a maximum of 10 modules during the application as the more approvals they received before enrolling in UM semester, the smoother it will be on their module registration when the semester begins.
4. Also, students are unable to enrol in clashing classes, so students are advised to be prepared with alternative options and submit them early for approval to avoid delays in their enrolment.

## Few things to take note:

- ❑ Undergraduate students are not eligible to take postgraduate modules, but Postgraduate students are allowed to take both undergraduate and postgraduate modules.
- ❑ It is mandatory for students to register a minimum of 6 credits (2 modules) and up to a maximum of 20 credits (6-7 modules).
- ❑ Students can choose modules from up to a maximum of 3 faculties.
- ❑ There will be an add & drop week whereby students are allowed to add modules but subject to availability and drop modules if there is any clashing of timetable.

## Important Note:

- ❑ It is the student's responsibility to make sure the online form is filled up accordingly. Please note that incomplete application will not be processed and is deemed unsuccessful.
- ❑ The modules listed in the application system are FINAL at the time the application system is ACTIVATED however there may be slight changes during the beginning of the semester due to an unforeseen reason.
- ❑ Universiti Malaya from time to time will notify home university's coordinator's regards to any matter related to student mobility programme.
- ❑ All fees charged to the student will be stated in the offer letter issued by the Universiti Malaya. The Universiti Malaya will not be responsible for any service fees charged by any third party (agents etc).


